We are clearing debris from fence line, salvaging fence, moving tree limbs into a burn pile, etc

Art Studios- 9-5 at 310 Art Studios in the River Arts District. They are trying to save this over 100 year old building.

Work is removing mud, drywall, and more from the building. They provide hard hats, masks, goggles, gloves. You need to wear boots, long sleeves, and pants. Also bring a change of clothes for afterwards. Show up and sign a waiver at the tent and get gear. They have some shovels there but a snow shovel is actually best. Hard work and very muddy but so worth it. Found a few art pieces that actually survived. We gave them to the studio owners who were on site.


