

# Shoreleave - Azzia

The entire solar system of the Azzians is located within a temporal space anomaly. This colorful irregularity was discovered by Captain Timothy P. Walters in 2214 and has come to be known within the Federation as the Walter's Temporal Anomaly. Attempts to enter the Anomaly without the Assistance of the Azzians has proved fatal, until the Arrival of the first ambassador to successfully make it to Earth, Lei'hallah Asrar 'Inayat Ve'hassi in 2384.



There are seven planets in the solar system, including the twin suns Dobi' and Do'dia.



Azzia is the Azzian homeworld and is approximately 10% smaller in radius than Earth. It has no oceans or high jagged mountain peaks such as are exhibited on several locations of Earth. The planet has an average temperature of 26.7 C. The atmosphere has a noticeable increase of oxygen levels compared

to Earth its gravity is slightly less than as well. It's only been about 7 years since they made contact with the Federation. Relations with the Romulans and Klingons are quite tense. The Azzian Technology level is approximately fifty years behind the Federation, except in holographic technology.

## Points Of Interest

### Starbase Far'dosi 128

Main base for the planet became functional in 2388 so it is less than ten years old. All ships dock here,



and from there you could teleport to anywhere on the surface or hire a shuttle.

### **Kov' dovi Province:**

Neighbors Tou' diasho to its west Kov' dovi boasts just as fertile of ground as it's neighbor though it is known also for the large lake known as Do' govi, its beer and an olive like fruit called Dobik'. The fruit can be eaten fresh, processed, canned or pressed into oils.

### **Cities:**

**Li'for:** With a population of six million. Li'for is the largest city in the Kov'dovi Province. Having two waterfronts the city is a popular tourist destination and famous for its west side eateries and south side shopping. Ki'for boasts a population of 6.3 million



**Sevo':** Built along the Hov'Lit River, Servo' is one of the oldest cities on the planet. With ancient structures over a thousand years in age still standing, many still occupied, the city is filled with museums, small shops and music festivals. Population is 38 thousand.

**Wosil':** Known as the beer capital, Wosil' hosts several festivals every year. With older architecture and smaller buildings the city has many breweries both large and small and a population of 1.2 million.

## **Festival Of Two Suns**

One of the most important festivals on the Azzian calendar where they spend two weeks celebrating that fact the suns shift in which sun follows. Dobi follows Lo'dia for the first six months of the year before appearing to take the lead.



Many events happen in celebration of this festival from fairs, family events to religious ceremonies celebrating the two suns. Off Worlders are invited to join in the celebrations and enjoy.

The festival is also host to Wosil's Grand Beer Challenge. Breweries from all over the Kov'dovi Province come to showcase their hard work and effort for a chance to win the festival's claim of Grand Champion in brewing for the year. Each year, brewers will submit beers of all types, from the traditional Wosil'weizen (a beverage that, when brewed to the proper



guidelines, is meant to taste different to every drinker), to innovations in the brewing scene, such as the Dobik'lager (naturally, a beer brewed with Dobik' fruit).

The Champion is determined by the oldest of Wosil's traditions; evaluation of the masses. Everyone who participates is meant to critique each beer they taste by way of short poll.
