  - Confident and Skillful workforce
- The Capacity category includes root causes such as:
  - Assigned tasks match current skill sets
  - Feeling energized
  - Workload within available time
- The Motives category includes root causes such as:
  - Feeling connected
  - Feeling satisfied
  - Being willing to remain in the organization
