HomeStretch

HomeStretch is a local non-profit organization dedicated to providing transitional housing counseling, and encouragement to deserving homeless families in the North Fulton area.

HomeStretch began over twenty years ago with leadership from RUMC and two other local churches. Today HomeStretch owns and maintains thirty homes used to house previously homeless families for a limited time, CUC has had a close and active relationship with HomeStretch from its very beginning. Our church supports HomeStretch through monthly donation used to offset administrative expenses. CUC participates in this through a monthly contribution of \$100 taken from our weekly Sunday School offering. Additional special offerings are occasionally taken in support of specific events and needs.

RUMC Foundation

CUC has one of the 27 RUMC Foundation endowment funds that benefit a wide range of RUMC ministries. Since 1991 the RUMC Foundation has distributed over \$900,000 to the ministries of this church. Overhead expenses are not included in the church budget. The Foundation has one annual fundraiser, the Malone Dodson Golf Tournament. CUC donates \$500 each year from our regular Sunday School offerings to defray some of the Foundation's overhead expenses.

Each year a CUC committee makes a recommendation to the class on how or where the investment income from the CUC endowment should be spent in support of RUMC and our missions. In 2016, CUC was able to give about \$2500 to three of our projects. Murphy-Harpst Children's Center, located in Cedartown, Georgia, is an agency of the United Methodist Church, M-H is committed to meeting the needs of abused and neglected young people through residential treatment or placements in specialized foster care and community programs that serve at-risk children. Expert therapists work with the children to evaluate their conditions and create a personalized treatment plan for the most appropriate living arrangement. The treatment plan and living quarters are designed to create an environment where children feel safe and cared for while undergoing intensive therapy. CUC has visited the M-H campus more than once and donated \$1200 from our CUC/RUMC Foundation fund to furnish dormitory rooms in 1916.
