Male: White Racist Soldier

√ We won't fight with you

End Harlem Hellfighters

√ Leontyne Price

Pronounced: **lee-on-teen**

... = very short breath

..... = full breath

Female: Leontyne as a 9 year old child

√ It's hard to hear from this colored balcony up here

- During this point in time, she is 9 years old.
- She is sitting in the audience at an opera hall. There are people around her, so she might be talking a little quietly.

Female: Leontyne as an adult

√ Ugh! Noooo! .

- These lines will sound very distraught and discouraged.
- More phrases like these can be added as well (we will need more depending on how long the scene ends up being.

√ Thank you, thank you!

- She will be saying this as people are cheering for her after a performance.

Female: Disgruntled racist Juilliard student

√ How did that colored girl get in here?

- This will be a disgruntled white person, looking at Leontyne as she is standing on a stage, singing excitedly at the Juilliard School of Music. She's the only colored person there.

Male: Racist producer

√ Nope. We are not going to air this.

- This will be the voice of a TV producer/NBC affiliate. Can be male or female.
- Voice will be disgusted and stern. Kinda angry

6-year-old Children: Two different voices

Actor: Cassidy

√ Wow! She's a beautiful black princess! (Cassidy)

- These will be children (different voices for each phrase).
- They are amused while looking at illustrated storybook characters.

- Dismissive and a bit arrogant but still serious sounding.
- Don't go too cartoonish with him, he was actually a pretty good guy and did a good amount of important civil rights work.

Female: Young girl 8-14

- Thankful for the apples (student)

Male Candidate 1:

✓ It really is a shame Shirley couldn't make it.

- White Man
- Delivery should be arrogant, waspy, and sarcastic
- You can be a bit more flamboyantly jerkish with this guy's delivery. But make sure to keep it realistic as well.

Male Candidate 2:

✓ Yes, it really is quite unfortunate.

- White Man
- Same kind of delivery as Candidate 1.
