February board meeting minutes approved as submitted.

2020 Crab Feed Refund: A live auction lot for a dinner at for 16 at Chateau Montelena was purchased by Jennifer Bennett at the 2020 Crab Feed, held prior to the Covid shut downs. As the terms of the lot can no longer be fulfilled, we are refunding her the \$4,000 she spent on the auction lot.

Hearts & Hands:

- We made \$1,800 on the dessert auction. Toni clarified the budget amount of \$2,000. The amount in the 2024-2025 budget is the amount made from Herb's Dinner at last years crab feed. The line item in the 2025-2026 budget will be \$1,800 reflecting what we raised this year.
- Per Mary Ellen, Millie thought that it was a standard \$2,000 donation. Mary Ann Salinger may be the best person to ask about donations from 2021 to 2023 club years.
- This will be put on a future agenda so that we can clarify it with Mary Ann.
- The question was raised as to what our donations for the last two years has gone to. Was it for the infant program or scholarships?

Teacher Appreciation Breakfast:

- There is \$1,000 in the Community Outreach budget that can be used.
- Trudy estimates a budget of \$350 for all three school sites
- It was moved by Marion and seconded by Nushi to make a board recommendation that we use \$350 from the Community Outreach budget for a Teachers Appreciation Breakfast on May 6th at all 3 school sites. The board recommendation was approved.
- Trudy, Mary Ellen, Nushi and Susan Leick will be spearhead our efforts

Ag Day at the Fairgrounds: We received a letter from Cheli Wright asking if we would like to take charge of beer sales with a profit split of 85% to SI and 15% to the City. It was generally agreed that we would pass with thanks for thinking of us.

- All clubs will help with fundraising
- Hoping to include Santa Rosa clubs as well
- There is a possibility of all participating clubs getting a grant from SIA
- Only costs would be meals, refreshments and speakers
- The request was made to add DIBI conference to the budget for the next club year
