

(The pattern is always Aff v Neg. So if your name is first you are Aff and if your name is second you are negative.) If you're struggling to put it all together, let me help you break it down. For Aff, you're basically writing a paper. Think of the beginning of your case as a preface where you tell the judge, "here's what we're talking about". Here's our value, criterion, and definitions. Oh, and in case you didn't know what the resolution is, here it is. Then, the body of your paper is the contentions. Three persuasive paragraphs about why your value is the best. The contentions should take up 4.5 to 5 minutes, meaning your "preface" is about 1 to 1.5 minutes. So, you're writing a 5 minute paper.... That's not too bad! And, right now, it doesn't have to be the full 5 minutes, although in a few months you'll struggle to get all you want to say into those 5 minutes! For the neg, it's the same process...only shorter because you have to leave about 2 minutes at the end to refute your opponent's case. So, your Neg case is squeezed into 4 minutes including your preface and the body which can be 2 contentions since you don't have a ton of time. Your preface can be slightly shorter than the Aff because you don't need to say what the resolution is. That's it!! You can do this! Write what you can, and we'll add to it and fix things over the next few weeks. Please try to make sure you're at co-op the next several weeks. See you on Friday! WRITING
