

NURSING SCHOOL PREREQUISITES

Courses below are commonly completed by Oxy students to fulfill nursing school prerequisites. Should you take courses other than indicated below, keep your syllabi. You may need them for future verification. Check official admissions requirements for each degree program and school as specific requirements vary.

BIOLOGY: ONE YEAR OR MORE WITH LABS

BIO 110 Introductory Biology: Ecology, Evolution, and the Environment

BIO 130 Introduction to Cellular & Molecular Biology

Prereq: CHEM 120, CHEM 130 or permission of instructor

MICROBIOLOGY: ONE TERM WITH LAB

BIO 325 Microbial Diversity

Prereq: BIO 221, BIO 222, BIO 224, BIO 270, or permission of instructor

BIO 336 Microbial Pathogenesis

Prereq: BIO 221, BIO 224, BIO 226, or permission of instructor

BIO 350 Microbial Symbiosis

Prereg: BIO 130 and BIO 105, BIO 106, BIO 110; or permission of instructor

BIOCHEMISTRY: ONE TERM WITH LAB

BIO 322 Principles of Biochemistry (for non-biochem majors)

Prereq: BIO 130 and CHEM 220, or permission of instructor

or

BIO 349 and CHEM 350 Biochemistry (for biochem majors)

Non-biochem majors may take 349 and 350 with the instructor's permission.

CHEMISTRY WITH LABS

Chemistry Placement Test is required before enrolling in the courses at Oxy. Check with each program for their chemistry requirements. Options:

CHEM 120 General Chemistry I (or CHEM 130 AP General Chemistry with AP scores of 4 or 5)

CHEM 220 Organic Chemistry I

Prereq: CHEM 120, CHEM 130, or permission of instructor

CHEM 221 Organic Chemistry II

CHEM 240 General Chemistry II (Integrated Concepts in General Chemistry)

ENGLISH: ONE YEAR

Two semesters of Oxy's <u>First Year Seminar (FYS)</u> courses (formerly the Cultural Studies Program) are accepted. Some schools may require/prefer courses offered by the English Department to meet this requirement.
