The following is what is commonly referred to as a "Supply List" that teachers send out to parents each year so that students can come prepared on the first day of school with the appropriate supplies. You will notice that the list is called "Requested Donations." TPS is not allowed to charge students or require students to pay for materials and supplies that are needed for daily instruction or activities. However, these supplies are needed to accomplish the vision and mission of TPS, and would be greatly appreciated as donations.

Again, this list of materials is not at all mandatory and we do not want parents to feel any pressure to purchase them. At the same time, if you would like to donate any or all of these supplies to your student's classroom, it would be greatly appreciated by the school and especially by your student's teacher. Requested Donations From Every Student: The following are for Shared Classroom Use and should
NOT be labeled with the child's name.
2 six packs of Elmer's all purpose school glue sticks
1 box of Crayola broad-line markers (10 count)
1 box of Crayola colored pencils (pre-sharpened)
3 boxes of Kleenex
3 containers of unscented baby wipes
3 containers of antibacterial wipes
10 containers of Play-Doh (3 oz or larger)
1-2 pump bottles of hand sanitizer
1 pack of 12x18 construction paper
1 ream of cardstock (any single color)
