

Perlin Privacy Policy

Perlin is a handmade craft idea catalog that helps you organize saved makes by sweetness band, manage favorites, and review collection insights. This Privacy Policy explains how information is handled when you use the app.

Your Rights and Self-Management

You control information associated with your use of Perlin. Under applicable data protection laws, you may have rights to access, correct, delete, or restrict certain processing, and to withdraw consent where processing is consent-based.

In-app controls let you manage most data without a formal request:

- View, edit, and delete craft makes, craft type tags, voice memos, and reference photos stored on your device.
- Adjust filter preferences and keeper pins at any time.
- Export a one-click archive of your personal tool usage data, including catalog entries, craft type labels, sweetness band assignments, estimated make times, keeper status, and related metadata, through the in-app text and CSV summary export.
- Remove attached photos or recordings by deleting the related make or memo.
- Decline device permissions in system settings to stop optional media features.

Contact us if you believe your rights have not been respected. We will review reasonable requests in line with applicable data protection laws.

Information We Collect and How We Use It

Perlin is primarily an offline utility. Most information stays on your device and is not transmitted to Perlin servers.

We may process:

Information you create

- Craft make records (names, craft types, sweetness bands, estimated minutes, notes, keeper status).
- User-defined craft type tags.
- Reference photos and voice memos you choose to attach.
- In-app currency balance and purchase records for optional Sugar coin packs.

Device and usage information

- A locally generated device identifier for quick access without registration.
- Limited diagnostic logs generated on your device when errors occur.

- Feature preference tags you set while using Perlin, such as selected sweetness band filters, craft type filters, and display choices, used to personalize how the app presents your catalog and insights.

We use this information to deliver catalog, favorites, sweetness spread analysis, exports, and optional purchases. We do not use your catalog to build advertising profiles.

With your permission, Perlin may access camera, photo library, microphone, and photo library write access for attaching media or saving exports you initiate. Denied permissions disable related features only.

Sharing and Disclosure

Perlin does not sell your personal information.

We may share limited information only when:

- You give explicit authorization before any sharing with a cooperation partner, following an internal compliance risk assessment covering purpose, data minimization, and contractual safeguards.
- Service providers support optional commerce features (such as app store purchase processing) under confidentiality obligations.
- Disclosure is required by applicable law or needed to protect users and service integrity.
- A merger or asset transfer occurs, subject to continued protection consistent with this policy.

Exports you save or share through your device remain under your control.

Technical Protection Mechanisms

We apply measures appropriate to an on-device tool, including:

- Storing catalog data and media in the app sandbox.
- Saving user media with relative paths within the application documents directory.
- Requesting camera, microphone, and photo access only after you grant system permission.
- Using platform secure storage for purchase deduplication keys and consent flags where supported.
- Collecting only data needed for features you choose to use.

No electronic storage is completely secure. You are responsible for device and backup security.

Operational Compliance Workflow

Our operational privacy practices include:

- Reviewing feature changes for data impact before release.
- Documenting permission purposes in store listings and in-app disclosures.
- Responding to user inquiries within reasonable timeframes.
- Conducting partner due diligence when cooperation involves data handling.
- Retaining operational records only as long as needed for support and fraud prevention, not for indefinite marketing.

Material policy changes will update the "Last Updated" date.

Data Retention

Craft makes, tags, media, and preferences remain on your device until you edit or delete them, or remove the app. Uninstalling Perlin typically removes local app data subject to platform behavior.

Purchase validation records may be kept locally for a limited period to prevent duplicate crediting. Support messages are kept only as long as needed to resolve inquiries.

Children's Privacy

Perlin is not directed to children under 13. We do not knowingly collect personal information from children. Contact us if you believe a child has provided information through the app.

Tool Function Compliance Adaptation Clause

Perlin adapts compliance to how you use specific functions:

- Catalog and insight features use local processing only and do not require uploading makes to a Perlin server.
- Media features operate only after you grant permission and choose to attach or export content.
- Commerce features follow platform store rules and may involve transaction data handled by the app store provider.
- Export features place output under your control through your device's save or share workflows.

You agree to use each function lawfully, including obtaining rights for imported content and not using exports to infringe others' rights. Perlin may restrict features where misuse is detected or compliance requirements change.

International Users

Perlin may be used in multiple regions. Because most data remains on your device, cross-border transfer by Perlin is limited except where you choose to share exports or where app store providers process purchase data under their own policies.
