

Lincoln Archers Draft Use of Photographic and Recorded Images Policy

1. Introduction

The use of images for promotion, celebration of achievements, and archival purposes is an important part of celebrating our sport and club. However this needs to be balanced by the need to safeguard children and young people as well as those adults who do not want to be identified.

2. Consent

Written consent from parents/carers and the child/young person for taking and using their images using the Archery GB Photography and Filming Consent Form.

If you are an adult who does not wish to be identified please inform the club Safeguarding Officer.

3. Use of Images

Clearly state how the images will be used and for what purposes.
Ensure images represent the sport positively and do not put children at risk.

4. Safeguards

We will follow Archery GB's SCG 05 - Photographing and Filming Children/Young People in Sport Policy.

5. Storage and Access

We will store images securely and ensure they are only accessible to authorised persons

6. Online and Social Media

Members are encouraged to share images of themselves on social media but must not include others without explicit consent of the archers or their parent/guardian.

7. Responding to Concerns

Any concerns about inappropriate use of images or clarification regarding this policy should be raised with the club's Safeguarding Officer.

8. Education and Awareness

This policy will be placed on the club website and brought to the attention of new members, volunteers, and parents of junior members.

The policy will be reviewed annually by the Safeguarding Officer to reflect changes in technology and best practices and to align with Archery GB's policies and legal requirements.

9. Compliance

We will ensure compliance with data protection laws and regulations as advised by ArcheryGB.
