WHAT IS IDENTITY (get to know me better) DAY?


This project helps others see your interests, likes, hobbies, passions, things you excel at, learn about your family and more.

- (SELECT 2): What is something you do that makes you feel energized when you do it?
 - What is one of your strengths or talents?
 - Art? Drama? Music? Dance? Sports? Horseback Riding? Leadership?
 - Trades? (Mechanics? Building? Cooking/Baking? Sewing? Technology?)
 - Reading? Math? Science?
- (SELECT 2): What are two things you are proud of?
 - Who are you? What makes you... YOU?
 - What is your family history and/or family culture?
 - o Is there an accomplishment you want to share?
 - o Did you want to share about your pet(s)?
- What do you love to do more than anything in the world?
 - What interests you?
 - Lego? Stuffies?
 - What do you like to do with your friends? With your family?
