1. Your group will present a cohesive Google Slideshow to the class regarding your topic. Each individual presentation should be between 1-2 minutes.
2. Each group member is responsible for creating and presenting three slides to the class. Each slide must have no more than 20 words and at least one picture. Put only your main ideas on the slides. You may have notecards, but be warned that if you simply read your presentation, grading begins at a C. **Do not rely too heavily on note cards.**
3. **The presentations should be interesting as well as informative. Search the Internet and the media center resources to find information about your assigned topic. Remember, it is best to give some background about the topic, and then EXPLAIN WHY/HOW this is relevant to us today.**
