Key responsibilities

The Analyst will spend up to 80% of their time on projects issued by Jumpstart Refugee Talent and 20% of their time on projects issued by Propel Impact. During the week, Analysts will participate in a speaker series curated by Propel and other personal & professional development opportunities.

Propel Impact projects:

- As a cohort, the Propel Analysts will work on a national-scale research or capacity-building project supporting the social innovation and social finance sector in Canada. This project will allow Analysts to work with each other across various cities and host organizations.
- Analysts may support the development, growth, and specific needs (ex. market research, impact measurement, financial/investment, marketing & communications) of one social enterprise.
- **For returning Analysts only:** Take the lead on at least one cohort-wide session by hosting a workshop or moderating on a topic you care about. You'll be responsible for organizing and guiding the full hour.

Jumpstart Refugee Talent projects:

The Analyst's work will support the development of the Refugee Impact Fund, including (but not limited to):

- Participate in the design
- Participate in investor relations related projects

The ideal Analyst is someone who:

- Has strong self-awareness, empathy, and emotional intelligence
- Has strong intercultural competency, awareness, and appreciation for people with diverse backgrounds and experiences
- Has demonstrated interest and knowledge in social/environmental issues, social enterprise, and/or impact investing
- Has demonstrated excellent ability to perform the following skills:
 - Financial modeling
 - Impact measurement
 - Investment analysis
 - Research and quantitative or qualitative data analysis
- High level of initiative, organization, self-motivation, and problem-solving skills
- Is able to take initiative, be flexible, and work well under uncertainty
- Possesses excellent verbal and written communication skills
- Has desire to support the growth and development of the Canadian social innovation sector (social enterprises, impact investing funds, charities, non-profits, co-operatives)
- Has the drive to make a tangible difference in both oneself and in one's local and global community
