Goals

Goal #1: The Oak Ridge School District will foster and facilitate open, reliable communication between the district and its stakeholders.

- A. The district will develop a communications plan to provide two-way communication with all stakeholders.
 - a. Establish a communications committee including a representative from each stakeholder group.
 - b. Identify methods to communicate with external stakeholders including parents and community. (newsletters, parent/teacher conferences, Remind, social media, SIS, website/app, calendars, district-wide public events)
 - c. Identify methods to communicate with internal stakeholders including students, administration, faculty, staff, and board of education. (Student communication in Advisory. Other ways to communicate directly with students? (i.e. electronically email, Remind, etc.)
 - d. Establish timelines and frequency of communications.
 - e. Identify opportunities for stakeholders to provide input on a regular basis.
 - f. Identify a central point of communication for the whole district (where communication starts) How messages are coordinated/sent out.
 - g. Create a communication protocol to ensure that communications are accessible to everyone.
 - h. Increase student participation at board meetings.
- B. The district will conduct an annual survey of all stakeholders.
 - a. Identify survey timeline.
 - b. Identify survey instrument.
 - c. Results will be reviewed and communicated to all stakeholders.
- C. The district will annually communicate progress towards CSIP goals.
 - a. The CSIP steering committee will meet annually to review progress.
 - b. The board of education will receive monthly updates on CSIP progress.
 - c. A district report card will be developed and shared with the public annually.
- D. Increase parent engagement/information available to parents.
 - a. Review format for parent/teacher conferences.
 - b. Develop a student showcase.
 - c. Identify additional opportunities at each level to engage parents.

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Goal #2: The Oak Ridge School District will attract, support, and retain high-quality faculty and staff.

- A. The district will provide a competitive salary schedule and benefit package as funds are available.
 - a. Analyze the Budget revenues and expenditures and provide regular updates.
 - b. Utilize salary committee to identify a process for the annual review of salary and benefits.
 - c. Financial Plan will be established for long-range planning/goal-setting.
- B. The district will foster a culture that supports teaching, learning and student success.
 - a. Establish and utilize a Professional Development Committee (PDC) to develop and carry out the PD plan.
 - b. Create a plan to implement DCI.
 - c. Establish a plan to formally recognize staff.
- C. The district will provide opportunities for faculty to collaborate.
 - a. Create a calendar that provides collaboration time.
 - b. Investigate alternate schedules to allow weekly collaboration.
 - c. Provide professional development on effective collaborative teaming.
 - d. Review opportunities for vertical teaming.
- D. The district will provide adequate resources to support teaching and learning.
 - a. Create a schedule to review and replace curriculum resources.
 - b. Develop a schedule to update technology resources.

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Goal #3: The Oak Ridge School District will improve student performance on multiple measures focused on academic, social, and emotional success.

- A. The district will ensure that all curriculum and instruction is aligned to the Missouri Learning Standards.
 - a. Provide time and support for teachers to develop and align curriculum.
 - b. Create a curriculum review cycle.
 - c. Implement instructional practices that include the use of learning targets to increase student efficacy.
- B. The district will implement District Continuous Improvement (DCI).
 - a. Create a District Leadership Team (DLT).
 - b. Create Building Leadership Teams (BLTs).
 - c. Create collaborative teams (CTs).
 - d. Create implementation plan for DCI.
- C. The district will implement a comprehensive assessment system including state and local assessments.
 - a. Provide professional development on common formative assessments (CFAs).
 - b. Develop an Assessment Plan.
- D. The district will develop a process for collecting and analyzing student performance data.
 - a. Provide professional development on data-based decision making (DBDM).
- E. The district will create an implementation timeline to provide a comprehensive multi-tiered system of support that addresses the academic, emotional, behavioral, social, and physical needs of each student.
 - a. Provide MTSS professional development.
 - b. The district will provide research based professional development on literacy and numeracy.
 - c. Establish a district-wide framework for tiered interventions.
 - d. Collaborative teams will identify tiered interventions.
 - e. Educate stakeholders on opportunities for engagement.
 - f. Create opportunities to recognize students for academic growth.
