



Step 1

1. Examine the legend for the 1750 political map to determine how the size of cities is represented.
2. Using the 1750 Political Map, identify six cities with populations over 200,000 - the largest size of city size in 1750, according to this map.



Step 2

1. Now take a look at the legend for the 1871 Political Map. Notice the symbols designating the size of cities, and also the numbers of people associated with each city.
2. In broad terms, how has the size of cities changed between 1750 and 1871?

3. Now locate all of the cities with populations larger than 1,000,000 people on the 1871 Political Map and **label these cities on the 1871 Blank Map.**
4. Examine the map you have created. Remember that urbanization is associated with industrialization. Based on the locations of the three largest cities in the world, **identify two places where you think industry had emerged in this period. Shade those regions on the map**
