ESSMY and VJM School Councils have booked Jo(e) Social Media! They will be presenting to students at both schools during the day (ESSMY in the morning and VJM in the afternoon) on Monday, April 17. ESSMY will host a parent presentation between 6pm-8pm that same evening.

Minister's Parent Advisory Committee

The second meeting took place Saturday, February 4th. Round table discussion about parent experiences with: How we felt our children were supported through their education journey/how they are prepared for the future and What can schools, boards, community and government do to support learners/what is working well/where could we innovate? There were presentations from Alberta School Boards Association, College of Alberta Superintendents, Association of Independent Schools and Colleges in Alberta and the Alberta Association of Public Charter Schools.

It was asked if the government would restore funding to ASCA and the response from Minister Lagrange was that the government does not fund "Associations" and that ASCA is eligible to apply for grants. A follow up question was asked about Alberta Education then providing school councils with access to free and reputable information on its' website. Minister Lagrange said she would take the question back to her staff. The next meeting will be in April after which time the election will determine next steps for the MPAC.
