ADMISSIONS TO NURSERY

A child cannot be considered for admission until after his/her third birthday. Morpeth All Saints First School admits in September, January and at the beginning of the summer term, but there will not always be a space immediately following the birthday. The admission list is drawn up in April, November and February. Names are listed according to the criteria defined in our Nursery Admissions Policy. This policy is available on our website or a copy can be obtained from the school office. In taking names from the list and allocating places, we will aim to ensure a gender balance within each session.

Please note conditions and sign

- There is no statutory right to a nursery place. If places are oversubscribed, the school will apply the admissions criteria set out in our Nursery Admissions Policy to determine which children to admit. If a child cannot be offered a place there is no right of appeal against that decision.
- 2. A child will complete the nursery course and remain in the nursery class until he/she is eligible to transfer to full time provision in a first school. (This provision may be waived if, for instance, parents move house and it is no longer reasonable for the child to continue to attend this nursery).
- 3. The time to transfer from the nursery to a First School is at the beginning of the Autumn Term if the child is four by 31 August. In exceptional circumstances, transfer may be delayed to the beginning of the Spring Term by mutual agreement with the Nursery Teacher and the Headteacher of the School.
- 4. Once a child is admitted to Nursery, regular attendance is expected.

We offer 15 hours per child, which is allocated to 5, 3-hour sessions per week in either the morning or afternoon. Places where there are less than 15 hours allocated to Morpeth All Saints, can be given when the nursery is undersubscribed, but are subject to change if there is competition for places. In that event children wanting 15 hours will be prioritised.
