The student activity program and organizations are an extension of the academic curriculum and are intended to complement the basic instructional program. Each sponsor will treat student activities with the same attention given regular classes; i. e., plan and evaluate the activity and make recommendations concerning changes, continuance, or deletion from the school's activity program.

Student activity programs must function within the framework of the school system's educational and organizational program.

To this end:

1. Student activities' groups will not participate in state or national activities not on the list of approved activities published by regional accrediting agencies or appropriate state and national principals' associations.
2. Decision as to the involvement of student activity groups shall be made by the responsible administrators in terms of the best interests of the students and of the Oneida Schools.

All student activities after or before school hours must be under supervision of the principal or a member of the staff designated by the principal.
