Executive Order No. 20

TO: Assembly of Greater Appalachia

Whereas, each governor deserves the opportunity to leave a representation of themselves in the governor's residence.

Whereas, the arts are something that allow an expression of memories and feelings in a unique way.

Therefore, I, Damarius Maneti, Governor of Greater Appalachia, hereby order the following:

Section 1. Commissioning of a Painting

(1) A 6 foot by 6 foot square painting of Governor Damarius Maneti's Corgi "Donut" shall be commissioned with the artist being determined through a vetting process as determined by Damarius Maneti.

(2) The funding for this painting shall be taken from the salary of the Governor of Greater Appalachia.

Section 2. Installation of the Painting

(1) The painting shall be installed on the wall directly opposite from the footboard of the bed in the primary bedroom of the Appalachian Governor's Mansion.

(2) Removal of this painting and every subsequent painting shall cause a second painting to be commissioned of size 9 foot by 9 foot of the same subject matter and affixed in the same position upon the wall.

(3) The funding for this second painting shall be taken from the salary of the Governor of Greater Appalachia at the time of removal.

Section 3. Enactment

1. I direct the Speaker of the Assembly to take the steps necessary and proper to ensure the publication of this Order in the Regulatory Notice Register and the dissemination of the publication to all State agencies.

2. This Order takes effect immediately upon publication in the Regulatory Notice Register.
