- Submission will be a 3-5 minute video, as well as a GitHub link with your project code
 - Submit video link (YouTube, Vimeo, etc) to Devpost
 - Explain project and idea in the video
 - Short timelapse featuring your work progress (proof of original work and non-Al generated content)
 - Upload your code to GitHub
 - Demo your project
