National Signing day is the first day in the college recruiting calendar where students can officially sign their National Letters of Intent (NLI) to commit to a NCAA DI or DII institution. National Signing Day is a way for student athletes to celebrate their commitment to play collegiate sports. By signing their NLI, students are committing to the NCAA institution for at least one year and acquiring a scholarship to do so. Once a NLI is signed, the students cannot be recruited by other schools.

National Signing Day is a widely celebrated event, most often seniors, who sign their NLI surrounded by their close friends, family, and coaches.
