JSP 830

Punishment System of the British Army

The Manual of Service Law provides policy guidance and reference material.

The Royal Military Police and Intelligence Corps are noted as “Peacekeeping Officers” tasked with ensuring the peace and stability of the British Army. Should any individual violate the stated rules and regulations, punishments will be issued per the Manual of Service Law.

Article 1.

Admin Abuse (Disciplinary)

- *To use administrative commands recklessly and intentionally.*

Punishment:

Punitive Discharge (Regiment)

Procedure

1. Crime to be recorded and submitted to the Intelligence Corps.
2. The individual is to be kicked from the game using Moderation Commands.
2A. If the individual continues to rejoin, immediately alert Headquarters to personally come to the scene and ban the individual permanently.
2B. If the individual does not rejoin, await Headquarters' response, and Headquarters will ban the individual accordingly.

Article 2.

Trespassing (Disciplinary)

- *With or without intentions to trespass into another private area without authorisation.*

Punishment:

Verbal Warning

Procedure

1. To be verbally warned and escorted out of the premises.
1A. If the crime is committed again, incarcerate the individual for 60 seconds.

Article 3.

Impersonation (Criminal Conduct)

- *Pretending to be another person for the purpose of fraud or for no justifiable reason.*

Punishment:

Suspension

Procedure

1. Crime to be recorded and submitted to the Intelligence Corps.
2. The individual is to be arrested for 120 seconds.
3. Alert the regiment HICOM or Headquarters to suspend the individual.

Article 4.

Bribery (Disciplinary)

- *Offering, giving, soliciting, or receiving of any item of value as a means of influencing the actions of an individual holding a public or legal duty.*

Punishment:

Suspension

Procedure

1. Crime to be recorded and submitted to the Intelligence Corps.
2. The individual is to be arrested for 60 seconds.
3. Alert the regiment HICOM or Headquarters to suspend the individual.

Article 5.

Manslaughter (Criminal Conduct)

- *The crime of killing a human being without malice aforethought, or in circumstances not amounting to murder.*
- *If the person murdered has been justified to be executed, do not impose punishment on the individual who terminated the perpetrator.*

Punishment:

Incarceration

Procedure

1. The individual is to be incarcerated for 120 seconds.

Article 6A

Murder of 1-2 Individuals (Criminal Conduct)

- *The crime of killing 1-2 humans with malice aforethought.*
- *If the person murdered has been justified to be executed, do not impose punishment on the individual who terminated the perpetrator.*

Punishment:

Incarceration / Execution

Procedure

1. The individual is to be incarcerated for 180 seconds.
1A. If the individual is an active shooter, execute the individual.

Article 6B

Murder of 3+ Individuals (Criminal Conduct)

- *The crime of killing 3+ humans with malice aforethought.*
- *If the person murdered has been justified to be executed, do not impose punishment on the individual who terminated the perpetrator.*

Punishment:

Execution

Procedure

1. The individual is to be incarcerated for 300 seconds.
1A. If the individual is an active shooter, execute the individual.

Article 7.

Harassment (Disciplinary)

- *Actions or verbal actions to make one feel distressed.*

Punishment:

Demotion

Procedure

1. Crime to be recorded and submitted to the Intelligence Corps.

Article 8.

Obstructing Peace Officer Duties (Disciplinary)

- *Obstructing an officer who is attempting to preserve the peace.*

Punishment:

Incarceration

Procedure

1. The individual is to be incarcerated for 120 seconds.

Article 9.

Hacking (Criminal Conduct)

- *Usage of a code to manipulate any games owned by the British Army to give the user an unfair advantage or to inflict damage on others.*

Punishment:

Permanent Blacklist

Procedure

1. Crime to be recorded and submitted to the Intelligence Corps.
2. The individual is to be terminated.
3. If the Peacekeeping Officer has admin commands, kick the perpetrator or ban them.

Article 10.

Inability to Fix Appearance / Refusal to Wear Uniform (Disciplinary)

- *Refusing to obtain the correct uniform after numerous warnings.*
- *Refusal to obtain a realistic face or skin.*

Punishment:

Incarceration

Procedure

1. The individual is to be incarcerated for 60 seconds.

Article 11.

Obstructing Ongoing Operations / Trainings / Events (Criminal Conduct)

- *Putting at risk, with or without intention, the success of any operation a regiment/squad takes part in.*

Punishment:

Incarceration

Procedure

1. The individual is to be incarcerated for 120 seconds.

Article 12.

Disobeying Lawful Commands (Disciplinary)

- *With or without intention to disobey an officer's lawful command.*

Punishment:

Incarceration

Procedure

1. The individual is to be incarcerated for 120 seconds.
