Eureka 4: (Grade 4, Module 5)

- **Lesson 27:** Compare fractions greater than 1 by creating common numerators or denominators.
- Lesson 28: Solve word problems with line plots.
- Lesson 29: Estimate sums and differences using benchmark numbers.
- Lesson 30: Add a mixed number and a fraction.

Eureka 4/5: (Grade 4, Module 4)

- **Lesson 6:** Use varied protractors to distinguish angle measure from length measurement.
- **Lesson 7:** Measure and draw angles. Sketch given angle measures, and verify with a protractor.
- Lesson 9: Decompose angles using pattern blocks.

ELC:

 We completed our mini essays analyzing the autobiography of an author. We learned about the intelligence of crows and held our third literature circle meeting.

Benchmark:

- We finished our 5th unit: Technology for a Green Future
 - Our essential question for this unit is How do we make decisions about developing new technology?
- We talked about ways public transportation is helpful to our environment and different authors opinions

Social Studies:

 We wrapped our social studies unit by reading about different Indigenous cultures
