Let's take a bit of time to bat ideas around on this GDoc. Once we've revised it accordingly, we might run it by some of the non-Factioners on the Boards to get an outside perspective.

Rosters 101

Tiers

Champions are divided into three tiers of affiliation with each faction.

- **Core.** These Champions are so strongly connected to the faction that their absence would be strange. Factions almost always start with at least their full Core list.
- **Secondary.** These Champions have enough of a connection that their presence on the roster would be unobjectionable, though their absence would not be particularly problematic. Factions may start with some of their Secondary Champions. They're also fairly easy to recruit during the arc.
- **Tertiary.** These Champions have a very weak connection to the faction. Their presence is going to be somewhat odd, and will require some explanation. Factions have a very limited ability to recruit one or two of these Champions per arc. Recruiting Tertiary Champions is more costly than recruiting Secondary Champions.

Factors

The tier descriptions above reference "connections". We use three criteria to measure "connections" between a Champion and a faction.

- **Story.** Perhaps the most obvious factor is the Champion's lore: their background, their appearances in the Journal of Justice or other such materials, and their actions in past Factions arcs.
- **Theme/Feel.** Notice that the tiers are defined largely in terms of a hypothetical viewer's reaction to the Champion's presence or absence. Theme (or "Feel") refers to the Champion's overall tone: their appearance, their out-of-universe connotations (e.g. any "fantasy Asia" Champion will have bonus Theme points for Ionia), their voicework, their attitude. A Champion with a modest Story link and a strong Theme connection is a good candidate for a Secondary.
- **Gameplay.** Each faction tends to have its own distinctive playstyle. A Champion that synergizes with that playstyle, or otherwise makes the faction more interesting to play as or against, gets some extra points. (Note that a Champion who fills in a conspicuous gap in the roster is more likely to lose points from Gameplay: eliminating weaknesses tends to homogenize factions.)

Starting Rosters

Factions will generally start with all of their Core Champions, and perhaps some of their Secondary Champions.

Highlights

Here are some especially contentious entries.

Shurima

- **Skarner**

- [CCT] I see him as an “Ahri”, i.e., a natural Secondary with solid Theme and a moderate Story connection. But a lot of people seem to think he’s Core. Why? I suspect that there may be some confusions about the categories.
- [ANI] I put him as a core because he wants to protect his homeland? Or at least he did. Either way, if Varus is core to Ionia, so is Skarner IMO. If he knew there was a chance he could protect *whatever he’s protecting now* he would sign up on his own will.
- [NRS] I’d say he’s core because it seems like he has a vested interest in the area. Assuming he still has the same role of “Guardian of his people”. anything that affects Shurima affects his job. So it only makes sense for him to be active.
- [MUS] While having a strong thematic connection (giant magical scorpion) his connection to Shurima is vague at most. Unless a better connection is stated between Kalamanda and Shurima, he shouldnt be core. Maybe if the Brakhen were involved and buried underneath Shurima as well he could be a core character.
- [RST] Skarner has a huge interest in the well-being of Shurima, since his people currently lie dormant there (or whatever it is he’s protecting, but he IS protecting something there for sure). Honestly, he has more reason to be fighting for Shurima than someone like Nasus or Amumu, and should be upgraded to core
- [CRZ] Basically what rust said - he’s protecting something within the lands of Shurima. Because of that, Noxus is a huge threat to Skarner, as now Noxus is wanting to conquer Shurima and take the lands for themselves, rather than just raid them. That puts his entire purpose at jeopardy, and it’s questionable whether Piltover would be any better. Skarner would likely turn to Azir, as he isn’t an outsider to Shurima, and isn’t going to be launching an aggressive takeover, or destroying whatever he finds. Not only that, but as with Mount Targon, most beings in or around Shurima will want to band together under the threat of a Noxian invasion. As such I believe an alliance with Shurima is in Skarner’s best interests - they are the only faction this arc that will honor his duty, and whose interests align with his. In fact, I believe he would take the initiative and offer his strength to Azir, in order to protect these interests.
- [SKN] Said it in the thread, will say it here: Skarner’s new lore is that he’s protecting something in Shurima. He clearly has a vested interest in keeping Shurima off anybody else’s hands but a Shuriman’s.

- **Rammus**

- [CCT] While I can see an Amumu-esque argument for Skarner, Rammus really seems like he has to be a Secondary at most.
- [ANI] I’m “OK” with Rammus as a Secondary if Skarner can become primary. My main reason for core Rammus is because Shurima seems to be the only place he fits.

■ [CCT] I don't think Shurima being "the only place he fits" is sufficient to explain a Core placement.

- [ANI] I also think Rammus fits all 3 ideals pretty well. Rammus fits Shurima's "Run at your face"(Sivir + Rammus + Nasus) comp perfectly, his story is good, and his theming is perfect.
- [MUS] Despite gaining sapience in The Plague Jungles, his point of origin was always Shurima. Since this is technically his homeland, he could fit core or secondary. I'd personally go with core. Kind of a reverse case of Wukong in Ionia
- [EPZ] He really feels like a secondary at best, for either plague jungles or Shurima, but he really feels like more of a tertiary for the areas.
 - [CCT] Shurima being his homeland, without more, sounds like a pretty conventional Secondary argument. Like Lucian or Sona for Demacia, or Ahri/Wukong for Ionia.
- [CRZ] I'm unsure of any factions canon surrounding Rammus, but his meager lore basically amounts to "he was born in Shurima, and he wanders around Shurima and the surrounding lands doing stuff sometimes. oh, and you can't stop him" While he is a bit of a nomad, he definitely has strong ties to Shurima (spends most of his time wandering around it), as well as looking completely at home on their roster from both a theme and gameplay perspective. To sum up my thoughts, if he's Core for any faction, it's Shurima. Though, again, since he's a nomad it might be understandable to have him not be Core for any faction at all.
- [SKN] Rammus is locally from the area, though you could argue he's more of a Southern Lands champion. I'd say he's Secondary.

[CCT] I have to run. I'll fill in more highlights later.
