

How to Create a Works Cited

1. Go to drive.google.com
2. Create a new document
3. Name the document "Works Cited"
4. Put a title on the top of the page (**Works Cited**)
5. Open a new tab and go to **easybib.com**
6. Click "**Manual Cite**" on the blue box in the middle of the page
7. Enter all of the information for your article from your Background Information Chart (the one you filled out in class)
8. Leave any information that you do not have blank
9. Click "**Create Citation**"
10. Copy and paste the citation into your Google Doc
11. Return then indent the second and third lines of your citation

Your eventual Works Cited should look like this:
