

Recreational Programs Health and Safety Standards for Reopening



Peabody Recreation will be following all state and local COVID-19 guidelines.

As of 5/29/2021

General Operations:

- 6" Social distancing is encouraged but not mandatory.
- Contracted vendors are permitted on site.

Screening and Monitoring

- Staff and participants must self screen and be symptom free before arriving at any Peabody Recreation Program.
- There will not be an official screening/wellness check to complete before arrival.

Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) and Face Masks/Coverings:

- Outdoor Programs: Masks are not required when outdoors.
- Indoor Programs: Masks are not required, unless mandated by the facility owner.
 - Ex: schools and busses may require masks.
 - Please bring a mask to every program just in case it's needed throughout the day!

Group Size:

- Outdoor Programs: There is no limitation on group sizes.
- Indoor Programs: Group sizes will be determined and mandated by the facility owner.

Quarantining:

- A person who is symptomatic and tests positive can be with others after:
 - At least 10 days since symptoms first appeared and
 - At least 24 hours with no fever without fever-reducing medication and
 - Other symptoms of Covid-19 are improving
- An person who is asymptomatic and tests positive can be with others after:
 - 10 days have passed since the date you had your positive test
- Close contacts after a known exposure:
 - An unvaccinated person who is considered a close contact (within 6' for 15 mins over a 24 hour period), will need to comply with the 7/10/14 day quarantine requirements.
 - A vaccinated person has no quarantining requirements unless they are symptomatic.
