

Table ordering with QR codes


If you want to provide your customers with an even easier ordering experience when seated at one of your tables, or simply make it easier for them to find your website, then this is the guide for you.



Navigate to Ordins backoffice <u>here</u> and make sure that your restaurant has eat in ordering enabled. Then click on the Qr Generator in the left panel.



This will bring up a screen for generating QR codes. Qr codes can either be created for the landing page or a store menu. You can also define the specific language in which you want the website to show up with.



When selecting "Menu" you'll be presented with the option to select the store and order-type of the menu.



When selecting the eat-in option you'll be presented with the option to define a table name and table id.

If you only define the table name, this will appear on the checkout screen and on the order as a comment.

If you only define the table id, this id will be sent to Extenda/Superb when the order is placed.

We suggest that you fill out either both the table name and table id, or alternatively just the table name if you don't use the table system in Extenda/Superb.
