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Submitting Assignments Using Phones, Tablets, and Other Devices

Use the web browser on your device — not the Moodle app — to submit assignments. Many students use phones, tablets, or Chromebooks to access their courses. That's perfectly fine — as long as you use the web browser on your device.

DO NOT use the Moodle mobile app or the OpenLMS app to complete or submit assignments. The app is only meant for reading announcements, checking grades, and viewing basic course information.

Why you must use the browser:

The Moodle app does not fully support file uploads, text entry boxes, multiple file submissions, or embedded tools.

What to use instead:

Use Safari on iPhone/iPad, Chrome on Android, and Chrome or Edge on Chromebooks.

Steps:

1. Open your device's web browser (not the app).
2. Go to your college Moodle site and log in.
3. Open your course and click the assignment.
4. Select Add submission.
5. Upload your file or type in the text box.
6. Click Save changes, then Submit assignment.

Check that it worked:

Look for "Submitted for grading" status.

Bottom line:

Phones and tablets are fine — the browser is required.
