Dear Parents,

Due to a recurrent request of some titles by eighth graders, I have begun a new collection with restricted access. These books are reviewed as good examples of literature, but the content is for a more mature reader and I would not want them on shelves for a younger, less mature individual to check out. These books are for mature readers due to subject matter, graphic violence, and/or dialogue (language) that may be considered inappropriate for a younger audience, but is indicative of student discussion/behavior/topics of interest for high school students. If these books were given a rating for digital content, they would be rated as PG-13 or TV-PG. Professional reviews rate these titles as 8th grade –high school. Many of the titles are print versions of shows and movies that may be on TV or in the theaters. I have listed some examples for you below.
