\*Please collect the children's money in advance and pay by cheque at the entrance gate. Let the office know if your school need extra medals @ €5 each

- 2. Numbered Team lists and photographs should be have been sent to office@sciathnascol.com
- 3. Each school is responsible for its own supporters who **must** be supervised. This is particularly important in the stand and toilet areas. No spectators are allowed on the field. No children are allowed into the VIP section of the stands. People are prohibited from bringing glass **bottles** into the stadiums.
- 4. <u>Three Teacher Passes</u> only will be issued to each school for entry onto the pitch. <u>Please abide by this rule</u>. Mentors are not allowed behind the goals during the matches.
- 5. Jerseys (including those of playing substitutes) must be numbered. **Use the numbers** as **written on the team list**. Commentators for the videos will be using these lists to identify players, so please cooperate. (You have already submitted your team list.) A maximum of your team and 6 players per panel will be allowed into the pitch/dressing rooms. All others must sit on the stand. If you feel there is a clash of colours please email the office and we will toss for jersey colours

6. Some issues have arisen in the past few years in regard to overcrowding and unwieldy panels. Below we set out clear guidelines for our finals.

Each school is entitled to line out a starting team of players and a maximum of the same amount of substitute players. *A maximum of 6 children will be allowed in the dugout on finals day.* Accommodation for all other panel members will be provided in the stand.

A 15 a side team can have a maximum of 15 subs, 13 a side teams can have a maximum of 13 subs. 9 a side, 9 subs. However this is a maximum number and not a target.

- 7. A set of medals for the team and 6 substitutes will be provided for both winners and runners-up. Additional medals can be purchased by each school. These must be paid for prior to the presentation. Additional medals cost €5 each. A maximum of 25 medals will be given to each team. Please email the office if you need extra medals and include the payment with your entry fee
- 8. Teams must be present at least 30 minutes before the scheduled starting time of their game. Teams will be lining up 15 mins before the game.
- 9. We propose to "stream" each game. A deferred copy of this will be available at a later date. Further details to follow.
- 10. All schools to bring their own First Aid Kit
- 11. Pictures taken by photographers at finals may be published in the local papers.

### Páirc Uí Chaoimh

On Garda instruction there will be no parking for buses around **Páirc Uí Chaoimh**. Supporter buses are to drop the children off on the Marquee link road and walk up to the venue. The bus must move off and come back to collect the children after the game. Schools are asked to operate a "Drop & Go" system. Make sure to get the driver's mobile number to call the coach service for collection after the games, when you are ready. Please relay this information to Coach Operator in advance.

Team buses will be allowed to enter the tunnel, and drop off at the dressing room doors, so must approach the stadium from the Marina.
