Geographic Description of Sullust: "Sullust was a barren, obsidian world of lava streams and turquoise lakes. Native fauna such as ash angels foraged during the day and returned to nest at night, while rockrenders prowled the planet's underground. Because the planet's atmosphere was highly toxic, native Sullustans lived in technologically advanced subterranean cities that were highly regarded for their beauty. They commuted to work by lifts and shuttles that carried them to the factories on the planet's surface, alternating between day and night shifts."

## **Locations of Interest:**

- > Transit Line BK7: A joint personnel and supply line, this rail system connects various warehouse facilities and raw material processing plants, terminating at the semi-permanent garrison (To be named). The rail line is contained in a winding and looping tunnel system, some from hundreds of years ago and some pre-existing long dormant lava tubes.
- > AG-S Marius: Auxiliary Garrison Sullust, code named Marius, is the First Order's Semi-permanent garrison in the center of Byllurun. Located at the termination of Transit Line BK7, it is the focal point of the First Order's presence in the large underground city.
- > **IDF Drilling:** IDF Drilling is an Imperial Detention Facility located adjacent to but separate from Transit Line BK7. Held here are some those might consider political prisoners. Former Alliance Demagogues and those suspected of anti-imperial rhetoric and activities. The majority of those interred are natives, left stranded during the First Order's acquisition of the planet.
- > Supply Fleet Gomorrah: With the First Order's recent focus on the Interior, the bulk of their fleets have been reallocated to worlds of more inherent value, most notably within the Order's Industrial Sector. Though Sullust has been much stripped of tactical value, it remains an important hub, acting as the Galactic Eastern outpost. As such, a supply fleet designated "Gomorrah" carries many valuable supplies both to and from the ashen world. The flotilla is only moderately protected by a small force of several Cruisers, Frigates, and starfighters. Exact numbers are not known.
- > Biosphere Ruins, Sullust Surface: Though the biosphere itself was largely destroyed, ruins yet mar the surface of Sullust beneath where it was suspended. Several larger pieces of the structure still remain though they are lifeless, merely a husk of what had once been called a home. Beneath the shattered remains lie a broken and scattered array of caverns and corridors, some caved in while others appear almost pristine. Some wide, some narrow, these are the remains of what appears to have been a last ditch bunker system in case of danger, though some of the chambers and their layout suggest it was used in addition to the biosphere for

lodging and/or storage. Sieger has dispatched his Knights of Ren to investigate these ruins, combing them for anything of value that may have been concealed or left by the Jedi during the acquisition of this world.
