With the increased prevalence of wildfires throughout California, it has never been more critical for us to prepare for a fire in our area. A group of residents are taking action by pursuing Firewise USA recognition for our area, and we need your help!

Preparation for wildfire can take on many forms – from the choice of materials used in your home, how you landscape and maintain your property, to knowing what to do if you ever need to evacuate. - Learn how to harden your home through safer materials selection and building techniques
- Potentially qualify for home insurance discounts
- Get to know your neighbors
