SRS Bingo Night FAQ

What is Bingo Night? Bingo night is an SRS community event held at SRS. We play multiple rounds of Bingo over two seatings (4 pm and 5:15 pm). Bingo is hosted by our Home & School Association and raises funds for Home & School programming. All children must be accompanied by an adult, this is *not* a drop off event.

When is Bingo Night 2025? This year's Bingo night is Friday, February 28th.

Where is Bingo Night? Bingo night is hosted at SRS in the cafeteria.

What time does Bingo night start? There are *two* seatings for Bingo night. The first seating is 4pm. The second seating is 5:15. Please pre-purchase tickets before Friday, February 28th to expedite your entry into the cafeteria.

Can we bring our own food? You may absolutely bring your own food to enjoy while you play Bingo. For convenience, you can order a pizza on the H&S website with your Bingo admission, and it will be available for pickup at the Bingo night check in table. *Please bring your own plates, napkins, and beverages.*

Who can play Bingo? Everyone must purchase a Bingo card to enter. Anyone who pays for a Bingo card is welcome to play! We have prizes for kids who win each round! We will also have Door Prizes in 2025!

When and where can I buy tickets for Bingo night? Registration for Bingo night will open the week of February 14th. You will be able to buy tickets online and strongly encourage pre-purchasing your tickets. You must have a ticket to enter. In 2023 and 2024, our 4pm seating was sold out, so don't delay.

What's the deal with the basket auction? As part of the Bingo night fun, the Home & School Association puts together a number of fun baskets for a silent auction. SRS Home & School depends on the generosity of its families and local businesses. Most of the baskets are created through donations from SRS families. Donations are based on Grade-Level themes, which are listed below. Please drop off items in the SRS Lobby by Wednesday, February 26th. Local businesses and families also donate baskets, like the Taylor Swift Basket (Dixon Family, 2024) or the Harry Potter Basket (McKenna Family, 2023). Teachers also generously offer their time for Teacher Experience raffles. Tickets for the raffles are sold online both before Bingo Night and through March 3nd. Winners will be drawn on Tuesday, March 3rd. You do not have to be present to win raffle baskets or Teacher Experiences.
