Screening Tasks for **DRAMA**

The person recording must state each student's name, grade, and school at the beginning of each recorded screening.

Students being screened for Drama must complete the following tasks:

TASK ONE: Characterization

Have the student "act out" the action described using both their body and voice.

- 1. You find a bee's nest, poke it, and what happens?
- 2. Become any animal you choose and demonstrate the following feelings/traits: love, hunger, sleepiness, and anger.
- 3. You are a very old person and you are trying to lift a heavy object.

TASK TWO: Imagination

Give the student a simple object found in your classroom or home (pencil, stapler, eraser, etc). Then say, "Use your imagination to turn this object into three things that it is not. Show us how to use each of those objects."

TASK THREE: Monologue

The student selects a short monologue to present. The prepared piece should be **memorized** and about 30-45 seconds long. The monologue should be a piece that is already written and not something "made up" on the spot. Monologues can be obtained from a Drama teacher or any other online or published resource.
