Day Preparation Checklist

Clothing:

- Comfortable shoes -
- Nerdy attire, e.g. Comic shirts/dresses (Great for fitting in, though not necessary) -
- Any TAW attire (Not necessary, but great if you don't have anything nerdy!) -
- Clothing with pockets (Pockets are your friends!) -
- Jumper or jacket for if you get cold -
- A rucksack to store all your loot! (May be subject to door searches) -
- *OPTIONAL* Any cosplay is highly encouraged if you have a costume, though please read up on the cosplay terms and conditions beforehand. We also recommend you bring a sewing kit just in case -
- **TAW Shirt and Lanyard**

Hygiene:

- Deodorant (Please oh please trust us on this one, it's a must!) -
- Painkillers e.g. Paracetamol for headaches -
- Any medications you need to take e.g. prescription pills, inhalers etc. -
- Allergy medication if you have known allergies - Tissues -
- Spare contact lenses and/or glasses just in case -

Basics:

- Entry ticket (Obvious enough right?) -

- Wallet (if you want to buy anything inside) -
