- 1) List of volunteers trained (scanned sign in sheet):yes, send copies of sign in sheet, Rio has already been doing it. Type the volunteer list.
- 2) AHA will not make handouts: Yes, we can make copies. SREC can pay.
- 3) AHA Event Requirement: What would a AHA event be? What counts as an “event”? Each of our orgs has health fairs and health sites where members can get practice measuring blood pressure. We would be happy to help them out with volunteers but we don't want that to be a requirement to get certified. Check Change Control, from our understanding, was a way that we would help AHA. Can our health fairs count as sites?
 - not feasible for requiring all volunteers to be trained
 - not a formal training that AHA gives to anyone else gives
 - AHA starting to do more long term connections with communities to make a larger impact that just one day training
- 4) Sodium Pledge: we think it is a good idea but we don't have the power to force people to sign it. We can announce it during hypertension training. It can not be a barrier to hypertension certification. CPR Video: what is the purpose of the video? can we see the video? how do they envision it being integrated? we think it is too long for a training that already lasts 3 hours. For stroke information what would be include? Stroke we think that is a little more relevant. How would it be integrated in to the presentation?
 - what would the CPR trainings look like?
 - CPR popular, the trainings are \$10, something we get funding for
 - we are working with healthy campus initiative on campus
 - CPR training 1 minute just the basics (with both pre and post test) should take a total of 5 minutes
 - a list of our volunteers who are CPR trained and those who have seen the video, we could advertize the CPR trainings
 - SREC hoping to have all directors of student organizations trained with CPR with university sponsorship. To get university sponsorship we would need 1 director of each organization getting CPR trained
 - possibility to do the CPR video in our own organization general meetings or general volunteer trainings

- hypertension certification is a liability issue
 - our goal is to provide volunteers with clinical experience
 - AHA would like a more holistic training
- 5) Check Change Control: 20% of members is not feasible. 5 per mentor is too much, we think 2 is more reasonable. Where would the sites be?
 - scheduling has been hard
 - weekends would be better
 - maybe the current model is not feasible for UCLA
- 6) Decrease max # people trained from 60-50. What is the reasoning behind that?
 - how many students do we think we would want to get trained per training 80-90 fall quarter, 70 winter quarter, 50 quarter
- 7) Making sure trained health professionals are coming. We would also like an earlier confirmation about what trainers we can expect.
 - we talk with the trainers (Downey Adult School) and approve dates ahead of time with them to make sure they can come
 - AHA has been having a hard time getting trainers because they don't have staff trained from AHA who can do it
- 8) Training SREC Hypertension Subcommittee directors so they can then give CCC control trainings. With more trainings we could reach a greater number of people. It is more efficient if we could do the trainings.
- 9) Update MOU with new orgs.

Another partnership: City of Refuge Church Partnerships: want staff from AHA to come to their screenings, we could send UCLA students to do that, ID number for HIPAA privacy, assign a internship for for someone be a role to be inputting all the data, 3 health fair sites needed to complete the hypertension certification (they can collect 3 signatures on their card) might be hard to require for Spring quarter

Require all directors of the Hypertension Subcommittee to be hypertension trained

AHA will provide to the curriculum: CPR video, slide on stroke FAST

Water policy: bring water to all the trainings

They will send us a draft by next Thursday, We will review draft of MOU at next Thursdays meeting and send them back the edits and then send to legal council.
