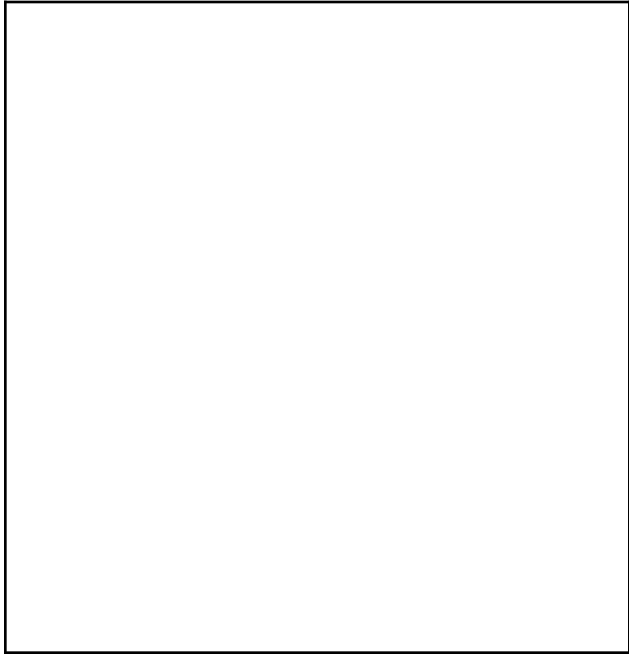


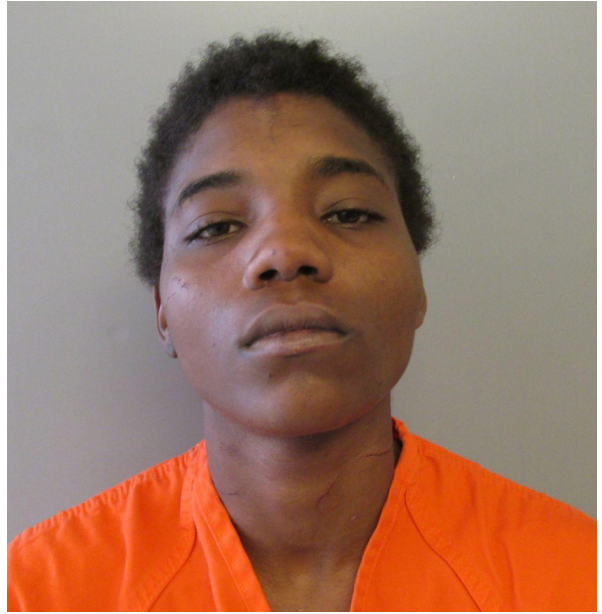

- Details - Sapulpa Police originally responded to a call of a "weapons complaint" at a cheap 2-star motel along Route 66 in West Tulsa. Upon police arrival, they found a teen girl in the parking lot waving them down, saying there was a woman nearby armed with a gun. Police found the woman with the gun, detained her, and apparently learned that there was somebody shot inside one of the rooms. The woman detained, Kamyra Smallwood, claimed that she shot someone in self-defense in her motel room, where she'd apparently been living as she had no other address. There, police discovered the victim, a teenage male, and pronounced him dead on scene in the bathroom. Police have said all three involved are young, and the teen male's mother was staying at the motel too, just in a different room. The victim and his girlfriend, 15, went over to Smallwood's motel room, where they drank alcohol and smoked weed. But at some point, an altercation broke out, in which Smallwood claims that the victim was apparently attempting to fight her. Smallwood pulled a gun and shot him, then fired several more shots so that "he wouldn't get up."

Court Outcome: Smallwood is a convicted felon and she wasn't allowed to have a gun in the first place. She has since been charged with 1st degree murder, contributing to the delinquency of a minor, and felony gun and AFCF charges.
