

Welcome to the 2020 Super Metroid 100% Tournament!

Runners of all skill levels are encouraged to compete! Discord (<https://discord.gg/2usVyy4>) will be the official medium used to communicate with players and schedule races. If you cannot use Discord but would still like to participate in the tournament, please contact an organizer at the contact information listed at the bottom of the rules.

FORMAT

The category for this tournament will be 100% item collection. The tournament will consist of 4 open qualifier rounds followed by a single elimination bracket. Racers may join as many qualifier rounds as they'd like (and there is no sign up requirement). Each qualifier round will consist of 2 races with the races being 12 hours apart (to hopefully minimize time zone issues). Racers may only join ONE qualifier race per round. A runner's single best time across all qualifiers will be used for purposes of qualification. Tied times will be broken randomly, but in the rare event that a tie would determine whether a runner makes the single elimination bracket or not, a special tiebreaker race will be run by all tied players for the bracket spot(s).

Following qualifiers, the top 48 racers will be seeded into the single elimination brackets. The bracket stage will end following the round of 8 where the remaining 4 racers will compete in a 4 way race to determine the winner. Runners will be seeded into the bracket, 1-48, based on their final standing following the qualifying rounds. The fastest time will be seeded 1, the second fastest 2, and so on through 48. The organization of the bracket will be "reverse-seeded" such that the first 16 ranked players receive an effective "bye", and then runner 17 faces runner 48, 18 vs. 47, ... 32 vs. 33. Matches will be best of 1 (first to one win). If players who are qualified for brackets elect to not participate in this stage of the tournament, invitations will not pass down and a bye will be seeded in the absent player's stead. Final standings will be determined by round eliminated with finish time as tiebreaker.

RULES

Players will use SpeedRunsLive to time and record their race. The time listed on SRL is the official time for the match. Races will use standard SRL rules. As well as the following:

All players are required to stream.

All files, unless otherwise noted should start at 0:00 with the intro sequence completed so play begins in the Ceres station.

Players may use cartridge, flashcart, or emulator (except SNES9x 1.43 and ZSNES which are banned).

Players may not use Major Glitches. For this tournament Major Glitches include (but are not limited to) glitches that take the player out of bounds, and spacetime beam. If you're unsure whether a glitch is considered "Major" ask an organizer.

Gold Torizo code is banned.

Failing to finish the game with 100% will result in a DQ (but players may reload a save made during the race to go back and acquire 100%). Players must save vods on their channels (contact an organizer if you are unsure of how to do this) even if a race is not restreamed (including qualifiers) to enable official verification of 100% item collection. Vods must continue until the credits show 100% at the conclusion of the run.

SCHEDULING

Qualifier Schedule:

19-20 sept Sat/Sun: qualifier 2 (9 pm EDT 19 Sept, 9 am EDT 20 Sept)

25-26 Sept Fri/Sat: qualifier 3 (11 pm EDT, 11 am EDT)

26-27 Sept Sat/Sun: qualifier 4 (9 pm EDT, 9 am EDT)

Note: US EDT is GMT -4:00. US Daylight savings time will end at 2:00 am on Sunday, November 2nd and US EST will then be GMT -5:00.

Bracket Stage Schedule:

28 Sept - 4 Oct play-in round of 32

5 Oct - 11 Oct round of 32

12 Oct - 18 Oct round of 16

19 Oct - 25 Oct Top 8

30 Oct - 1 Nov weekend Top 4 race to be scheduled

During the bracket stage please do your best to communicate with your scheduled opponent and get your match played before the deadline. If you are having trouble contacting your opponent please let the organizers know. If both players are considered no-shows (worst case), both players will be forfeited. Also please schedule your matches at least 24 hours ahead of time. We may not be able to restream the match with too short of notice.

RESTREAM INFO

Matches will be streamed to twitch.tv/speedgaming (or one of the alternate speedgaming channels) along with commentary. If you would like to help commentate matches please mention an Organizer to request the Commentary role. Organizers reserve the right to remove people from commentary should their commentary be deemed inappropriate and/or offensive.

Each race will get a 2 hour time block scheduled for the restream (depending on scheduling constraints this may be shortened or extended). If your race runs over time the race will continue but the restream may stop (DO NOT STOP YOUR STREAM).
