We are happy to share with you our partnership with Northeast Wisconsin Technical College (NWTC) to provide a vibrant program of study in the automotive industry. The Ahnapee Automotive and NWTC began a collaborative learning opportunity for our students to earn a college credential in high school and be in a unique position to prepare for the future workforce. Currently students in Denmark, Kewaunee and Luxemburg-Casco school districts can participate in the Ahnapee Automotive program.

Students interested in **Ahnapee Automotive** will enroll in the **Automotive Maintenance Technician (AMT)** program with NWTC. The courses will be taught at the Ahnapee Automotive at Luxemburg-Casco High School by NWTC instructor, Jacob Burt, and supported by L-C HS instructional aide, Rod Mleziva. Over two years -- junior and senior year -- students will have the opportunity to earn up to 26 college credits and a one-year technical diploma. Upon graduating from high school, students will be prepared to either enter the workforce directly or continue their education for one more year at NWTC to complete either a two-year Automotive Technician technical diploma or an Automotive Technology associate degree. **Ahnapee Automotive** is one of 16 high schools in Wisconsin to have earned the National Automotive Technician Education Foundation (NATEF) certification, ensuring students graduate with knowledge and skills needed to successfully work in the automotive industry!

Juniors and seniors interested in the AhnapeeAutomotive - Automotive Maintenance Technician Diploma program will complete an application and a short interview to be eligible for this program. [The online application can be accessed by clicking here.](#) All applicants will interview at your high school between 8:00 a.m.-3:00 p.m. with a team representing NWTC, the program director and representatives from your school district. Within two weeks of the interview, students will be notified if they are accepted to Ahnapee Automotive. Applications are available in Student Services and are due back by February 21st.
