How to make a Pinned Post for your Custom Feed (Step-by-Step)



Note: As of September 17, 2023, you cannot make a pinned post on your profile like you could on Twitter. However, you can make a pinned post for your custom feed.


This is in the scenario of making a pinned post for your custom art feed but this applies to any custom feed.

If you have not made your own Art Feed, you will need to make that first. <u>Click</u> <u>HERE to learn how to do that step-by-step.</u>


This guide will show the screenshot first and the accompanying text below it.



Go to your custom feed Click +Add Block




Select Input



It appears there.


Select Entire Network because we want to change that.



Select Single Post




So now, make a post that will be your pinned post.



When you make the post, click on it so you have a link address like the above. Copy the last part with the string of numbers and letters that you have (noted above)

Now paste that on a blank document to have it on hand for later.

Now go back to the Skyfeed Feed Builder



Copy your User DID information.

And paste that on a document along with the other item you copied.

So you should have copied

- The last section of the link address to your pinned posts
 - In this case it is: 3k6cbti33o22u
- Your User DID number
 - In this case it is: did:plc:wqxkatcfmjhtopmz56xckzsa

Now you will want to format the "Post URI" like this - Copy this (below):

at://[Paste User DID number]/app.bsky.feed.post/[Paste last section of link address]


Then paste your numbers on there.

In this case it would be:


at://did:plc:wqxkatcfmjhtopmz56xckzsa/app.bsky.feed.post/3k6cbti33o22u

Do all of this in a word doc or something similar so you can easily paste it over.


Copy it.



Paste it.



Now you need to click and drag the block to the very bottom of your blocks.



And then it will show at the top.

And you're done! Hooray!
