1) Create a CFNC account (USE YOUR PERSONAL EMAIL)

2) RDS (Residency Determination Service) - (sign in using your CFNC account) The RDS determines if you qualify for in-state or out-of-state tuition for NC schools and is open continuously! (RDS is confidential so any information you put into it will not be shared with immigration authorities) It is used in order to help you pay for school as an IN-STATE RESIDENT as out-of-state tuition is 3 TIMES MORE THAN IN STATE.

3) Create an FSA ID (FAFSA Account) and have your parent(s) create one too! (If your parent(s) DO NOT have a Social Security Number (SSN), that is okay! They can still create an account!) Here is a free, online, downloadable guide in multiple languages explaining FAFSA! The FAFSA (Free Application for Federal Student Aid) is to apply for Federal Student AID and opens on October 1st. BE SURE TO CREATE A FSA ID AND HAVE YOUR PARENT(S)/GUARDIAN(S) CREATE ONE.

4) Look into Scholarships! You can also start your scholarship search now. Look into the CFNC Scholarships. Scholarship applications also depend on the university! Check out the Durham Tech Promise where you could get up to \$1000 a year for attending Durham Tech! If your household income is below \$80,000 a year then you may qualify for the NC NEXT Scholarship which can pay for your entire year at a community college like Durham Tech! You can also look at more scholarships on my Scholarship Slide and bookmark ones you want to apply to! Check out the Jordan Student Services website on the scholarship page

## 5) Explore the Durham Tech Transfer Center

This is where you can learn everything you need to know about how to transfer from Durham Tech. If you are interested in transferring to a 4-year university after going to community college, please refer to the **transfer guides here** 

6) Complete the Durham Tech application! High school seniors who have not yet graduated receive provisional acceptance to the college once they have completed the enrollment application and residency determination. This allows students to get a head start on completing the enrollment process.
