

COMPASS ROSE

Vegetation all the plants and trees in an area




RURAL

An area outside of cities, countryside




URBAN

A large area of Earth's surface that shares similar characteristics.




Desert Region

A town or other area where people live in houses near a larger city.




GEOGRAPIC FACTORS

Natural features of the Earth's surface(mountains, valleys, etc.)




COUNTRY/NATION

An area of land that is controlled by its own government




POPULATION
