It is election day. Today, millions of Americans will go out to vote to select their state assembly people, and in Atlantic and Sierra, their Governors. Every single party gave it a good fight, and nobody's going to know what the public will be thinking on election day and what the results will yield. Here are my predictions for the State elections.

State Assemblies

Atlantic:

Atlantic was the only state where the Democratic Party did not run a list in. However, a star-studded Socialist and Republican list is teasing voters with noteworthy names. The Socialists in particular had major

names, including Speaker Parada, Representative PGF3, Representative KayAyTeeEe, and Representative Dartholo. The GOP had some noteworthy names, including dandwhitreturns and Superpacman04. The Socialists, in one of their few reliable states, pulled out with amazing campaigning, including some unique events, such as [a sermon by Rep. PGF](#) and [Rep. Dartholo going on a hike with his supporters](#), the Socialists really were unique. However, with the added support of the Democrats, it's likely the Socialist's will continue their hold of the assembly.

Prediction: 5 Soc, 2 GOP

Chesapeake

In the constant swing state of Chesapeake, there's likely gains to be had and losses. Chesapeake's Democratic list contained 3 former Democratic presidential hopefuls in NinjaDragon, ResignationGaines, and Plebit8080, as well as former Senator CDocwra and Chesapeake Democratic Chairman Googmastr. The Socialists had another former presidential hopeful in Tucklet1911, and even at the bottom, their frontrunner in dewey-cheateam. As all 5 of Chesapeake's congressional offices are held by the GOP, most expect them to do well here. However, they certainly don't have high hopes, only naming 4 people to their list. Surprisingly, an independent in abrokenhero, who's not noteworthy enough to gain any major media attention, and likely, won't receive the votes to gain a spot. Still, with multiple noteworthy names and people in power, this looks a very strong win for the coalition

Prediction: 4 Dem, 2 Soc, 1 GOP, 0 Independents

Dixie

Heading down south to Dixie, this is expected to be an easy win for the coalition in one of their shared strongholds. It's crazy to think about 2 years ago, this was a stronghold for the GOP, when now, they only contain one seat as a major seat in Senate Majority Leader PrelateZeratul's seat. People such as speaker Tripplyons18, stormstopper, and ClearlyInvisible led a major charge for the Democrats, while Senator Banana_Republic_ was strongly advocating for Socialist policies. Independent CryDefiance threw up a fight, but similar to abrokenhero, it won't be enough to get a spot. I expect this will be nothing more than a Coalition landslide to work with Governor BNG.

Lincoln/Great Lakes

In Lincoln, what was once seen as a liberal utopia, progress has started to be rolled back. An election of a GOP governor and a Democratic assembly was certain to be tense, but with the sudden removal of Governor Froggy and replacement with OkBlackBelt, the liberal policies are starting to be rolled back. The tense moments with the militias in Montana were enough to create a more tense partisan divide. However, the Democrats are expected to do great. However, it can't be confirmed to be true. A full Democratic List, including Murpple, Speaker IGotzDaMastaPlan and the return of cubascastrodistrict, it's likely the Democrats do well. Sierra

Polls have been tied between the Democrats and the Republicans during this period, and it'll be a true close race, as with its Gubernatorial race. Gubernatorial Races

Atlantic

Atlantic's gubernatorial race is incredibly fascinating. As expected, the Socialist nominee was incumbent Governor UnorthodoxAmbassador, and surprisingly, the GOP selected Senator _MyHouseisOnFire_, who unsuccessfully ran for Governor last year. However, since this is a Socialist Stronghold, and polls seem to shift now towards the Governor, this will go to the last votes.
