

- Thursday evening classes (conversation)

Who: adult public

How many hours: 1h30 per week

When: Thursday from 7:00 to 8:30 pm

How long: from 1 trial class and up to 12 classes

How many students: maximum 6 per class

Prerequisites: To have passed the A2 level.
Level is evaluated by a written and oral test.

Learning objectives:

To be able to speak fluently on a variety of subjects.
To extend one's lexicon on specific topics.
Linguistic reinforcement.

Our approach:

You will receive a written and oral evaluation beforehand to place you in the group that best suits you (A2-B1 or B1-B2). These evaluations will also serve to discuss your objectives.

Our group courses are of a human size and have a maximum of 6 students so that each student can have a significant amount of speaking time. We emphasize oral communication to facilitate exchanges outside the classroom.

These classes are 90 minutes long, which is enough time to study a topic in depth while keeping you focused and retaining the course content and information more easily.

This is a more informal class and does not require any final evaluation.

Content:

Each course is built around a main theme. The teacher can use a variety of materials (videos, articles, etc.) to spark conversation. The authentic documents are adapted to your level and will allow you to better understand and adapt to real-life situations. The teacher facilitates speaking, stimulates conversation, gives vocabulary and corrects. There is no grammar taught in the class.
