What is it?

The Battle of the Books is an extra-curricular reading program which runs approximately three months, and is designed to encourage reading of the best classic and contemporary children's literature, and to foster positive character development in the areas of teamwork, cooperation, and responsibility.

Who May Participate?

The Battle of the Books is exclusively for the fourth and fifth-graders in the South Fayette School District. Although participation is voluntary, all are encouraged to join a team. Students don't have to be a "top reader" to participate! Books on the reading list range in reading level. The only requirement to participate is a commitment to read two books from the selected reading list and to be available to attend the Battle of the Books Tournament on the evening of Friday, March 6, 2026.

How is it organized?

Students form their own teams of five members, choose a team name and color, and find an adult to serve as their team manager. <u>Team managers will need the following information from each team member when registering: first and last name, grade level, tee shirt size, and their parent/guardian's email address.</u>

The team divides the reading list among its members and begins reading. The team will meet at their convenience to design their poster, decorate T-shirts, and check up on their teammates' progress, etc.

What happens the night of the Tournament?

All teams will meet at the Intermediate School Gym for the Book Battle. Teams sit in circles and answer questions based on the books they have read. A moderator will ask a question, stating it twice, then each team will have 30 seconds to decide upon their answer and write that answer (and the author's last name) on a piece of paper. The team manager will record each team's score, and the scorekeepers will tally the results.

Who wins?

The team with the most points at the end of three rounds of questions will be declared the first place team. There will also be 2^{nd} and 3^{rd} place winners. No team scores will be announced.

Everyone who participates is really a winner! Each participant will have an opportunity to read some terrific books, have fun working with a team, and create some fantastic memories preparing for the tournament!

Parents, you can also be part of the excitement! Volunteer to be your child's team manager. Check out the Team Manager's Duties sheet on the Battle of the Books website.
