■ **Dancers to arrive wearing:**

- Showcase T-shirt
- Black or Bom Funk leggings / hot shorts / track pants
- Hair done & optional makeup completed
- Bring ALL dance shoes worn on stage – clearly named!

3:00pm – Dinner Break

- No students permitted to leave the venue at this time
- Please pack a simple, no-spill, nut-free snack and water only (e.g. dry biscuits, crackers, dried fruit, cheese stick, sandwich)
 - ✗ No yoghurts/dips requiring a spoon, popcorn or nut-based products due to spillage/allergy risk
- Alternatively, send canteen money or meet your dancer in the foyer at 3:00pm with food (to be eaten in the foyer only – no parents backstage)

3:30pm – Students Head Backstage

- Collect costumes & prepare for the performance

3:45pm – House Opens to Audience

- Warm-up continues in dressing rooms

4:00pm – SHOWTIME! Inter/Senior Showcase – “Time Flies: 20 Together”

7:00pm – Show Finishes

- Dancers are returned to the foyer by their Dressing Room Leader
- Parents to sign out dancers in the foyer
- No parents are permitted backstage

PROCEDURE FOR SHOWCASE DAY

PRE-SHOW

- Arrive on time at your group’s designated arrival time
- Go to the Sign-In Desk in the foyer – dancers will be directed or escorted to their dressing room
- Parents may wait in the foyer or leave and return by showtime

- Dancers may stay and watch the rest of rehearsal **or** leave after their rehearsal block has finished. If leaving, they **must** be signed out by a parent/guardian and return to the venue by 3:15 pm.

DURING THE SHOW

- Dressing Room Leaders supervise dancers throughout the event
- Students will:
 - Receive costume bag
 - Get changed backstage
 - Take professional photos
 - Perform on stage
- Finale: All dancers return to the stage wearing their Showcase T-shirt for a special award and a moment in the spotlight

AFTER THE SHOW

- Dancers may leave wearing their Showcase Tshirt
- All costume items are to remain at the theatre and will be collected on the day
- Students are brought to the foyer for collection and sign-out
- Parents are not permitted backstage

REMINDERS & REQUIREMENTS

- ✓ Arrive on time to ensure your dancer does not miss stage rehearsal
- ✓ Arrive in Showcase T-shirt, black or Bom Funk bottoms, hair & optional makeup done
- ✓ Bring all correct dance shoes for stage (must be theatre-approved)
- ✓ Label EVERYTHING – shoes, bags, clothes, etc.
- ✓ Students remain under Bom Funk teacher & volunteer supervision
 - All backstage adults hold Working With Children Checks
 - All Bom Funk staff are First Aid trained
- ✓ Students must remain inside the venue unless signed out by a parent or guardian

BACKSTAGE CARE

We take our job seriously when looking after our students backstage. That's why we ask you to check if the following circumstances apply to you:

- Does your child need medication backstage or require an action plan for a severe allergy/illness? If so, please fill in the [Emergency Action Plan Form](#).

SIGN IN/OUT PERMISSION

Students under 18 years must be signed-in and signed-out by a parent/guardian. If you would like to grant your child permission (aged 15-18) to sign themselves out without a

parent/guardian, we'll need a consent form completed by a parent or legal guardian in advance via this [Permission Form](#). Please submit this form by Friday 14 November.

RED CARPET FINALE

All students make a special appearance in the finale and receive their participation medal on the red carpet! Students cannot be collected during the show.

OUTSTANDING FEES

Term 4 invoices are now OVERDUE. Students with outstanding fees on their accounts will not be given costumes until payments are finalised. To avoid disappointment and the huge task of respacing routines on the day – please make sure all accounts are paid in full and Payment Plans are completed by the agreed date.

These online documents are dynamic so it will be updated as each class is finalised. If we have to make any changes after trying costumes on, we will mark these in RED font so you can easily see the changes.

WHAT TO WEAR:

All students are required to wear the costume and accessories provided, as per the official 'Costume Requirements' documentation above.

Some items may need to be supplied by families, including:

- Tights/stockings
- Underwear
- Socks
- Correct shoes
- Hot shorts, leggings or pants

FITTINGS & DISTRIBUTION:

- Costumes will be tried on in class once they arrive.
- If no issues are found, costumes will be:
 - Packed into a named costume bag
 - Delivered to the venue by Bom Funk staff
 - Handed out on the day of the Showcase

AFTER THE SHOW

- All students must return their costume items and accessories at the end of the event.
- Items must be returned in the original named costume bag.
- No costumes provided by Bom Funk are to leave the theatre.
- If any items are missing or damaged, the replacement cost will be charged to your account.

IMPORTANT NOTES

- Costumes are provided free of charge.
- As we accommodate a large number of students across various sizes and age groups, costumes may not always be a perfect fit.
- Teachers will assess each costume and advise on any major alterations before distribution.

Stockings and Shoes:

Every dancer is responsible for purchasing the correct shoes and tights for performance. We provide a safe dance & child-safe show and as such, require correct dance shoes and tights/stockings.

Tan tights and convertible/footless tights, ballet stockings, flesh briefs & flesh bodystockings are available to purchase from our Boutique. Toes thongs and some second hand shoes are also available to purchase from the Boutique - please visit in person. Limited stock only!

MAKE UP & HAIR REQUIREMENTS:

All performers in the Main show are asked to wear stage make-up. We believe every dancer is perfect just as they are and certainly do not need make-up in everyday life. However, stage lighting is a whole different story and without stage make-up, dancers

will look washed out and featureless on stage, especially in large theatres. Performers use stage make-up to enhance their own natural features.

We ask that all make-up be neutral tones (browns, pinks, etc) and based on the age of the dancer. We suggest that male dancers could use a little bit of bronzer to highlight their features should they wish. We ask all female dancers to have a brown eye shadow, pink blush and red lip colour. Older dancers can wear more make-up for stage and Squad dancers must wear fake eye lashes. You can find a quick tutorial for stage make-up and options on our showcase website.

HAIR:

Different dances have different hairstyles, so you and your dancer will want to review our costume requirements document to see what style he or she will need for each performance.

We have staff and older dancers backstage who can help your dancer change their hairstyle if required, but we will keep any changes to a minimum. Please pack the following in your dancer's bag:

- bobby pins /hair pins
- clear rubber bands/hair ties
- elastic bands that are the same colour as your dancer's hair
- gel (not hairspray due to asthmatics and smoke alarms)
- comb and brush

Hair styles for 2025 Showcase:

- SLICK LOW CENTRE PART PONYTAIL - All routines except Ballet
- SLICK LOW CENTRE PART BALLETT BUN - All ballet routines

All hairstyles are written in the costume requirements Document.

*Students with more than 1 shoe change should bring a separate bag (can be a shopping bag) with their shoes in it for rehearsals to take into the theatre.

If you or your child has 2 routines or less in a row, they must change in the Quick change area backstage in the Green Room.

Tips for Quick changes:

- Take out your shoe laces for Hip Hop & Tap shoes and replace with black elastic
- Use low cut hip hop shoes (like tennis shoes) with black socks instead of High Tops
- Wear a flesh bodystocking so you are always covered (available from our Boutique)
- Bring a plastic tub to throw everything into as you change so you don't lose anything
- Make sure everything is named!
