IV. Update on Reopening of Schools:

- A. Cohort A, Cohort B, and Cohort C students continue to participate in hybrid instruction. This will remain the model and schedule through the end of the 20-21 school year.
- B. Parents are asked to complete Online Registration for the 21-22 school year.
- C. The school year will open with students attending full-time face-to-face five days a week at all schools. Families who wish to continue with distance education will need to opt-in for distance education. The deadline to opt-in for full-time distance education is May 21, 2021, to allow schools time to plan staffing for the upcoming school year. Late requests for full-time distance education will be based on available space at each school.
 - 1. Distance Education, for students opting in, will be impacted by the number of students making such a request.
 - 2. Mannion Middle School will make every effort to not place students and teachers in a situation where they are in a classroom where teachers are teaching to both in-person and distance at the same time.
 - 3. As a result, elective and class choices may be limited.
 - 4. Parent requests to move in and out of distance learning will also be impacted by numbers.
- D. Mannion has scheduled Back to School Day for August 3, 2021 from 8 AM to 11 AM. Students and parents will get schedules, try lockers, walk the campus, etc.
- E. <u>Mannion has scheduled 6th Grade Orientation for August 2, 2021. Incoming 6th Grade families are asked to RSVP here.</u>
- F. First day of school is August 9, 2021

 - (c) Ceremony will be live streamed for parents to watch at home. Cohort A/B/C could also watch on their home day.
