Also discuss the theoretical findings of the service process from the beginning until the social changes occur. The discussion of the results of community service is strengthened by references and theoretical perspectives that are supported by relevant literature reviews. The reference must use APA Style 7th Edition. (Palatino Linotype, size 12, Spacing: before 6 pt; after 6 pt, Line spacing: 1.15)

Conclusion (Palatino Linotype, size 12)

Contains a description of result conclusions toward community service in the form of theoretical reflection and recommendations. (Palatino Linotype, size 12, Spacing: before 6 pt; after 6 pt, Line spacing: 1.15)

Acknowledgements (Palatino Linotype, size 12)

Contains descriptions of acknowledgments or acknowledgments to parties
