

TREES!

Trees fascinate children and spark their curiosity and wonder. Close your eyes, and think of your childhood memories that involved trees. Did you ever climb a tree? Did you chase and hide behind a tree? Did you lie down under a tree and wonder whether it touched the sky? Throughout this study we will build upon children's interest in trees to help them explore science and social studies. Rather than emphasize naming different trees we will focus on helping children develop an understanding of the characteristics of trees and their roles in our lives.

We will be planting a tree with members of the Potawatomi Language School and they will teach us words for: tree (mtek), earth (ke), and leaves (tatpekwen). During the study the children will use skills in literacy, math, technology, and the arts to investigate and represent their knowledge about trees.
